### "D" System - Draft Beer Keg Coupler - Tap with Black Lever Handle

"D" system is the most common system available in the US, also known as American Sankey. It is used by all the major breweries - Anheuser-Busch, Miller, Molson-Coors, and Labatt as well as most craft breweries. Please see page 2 for an expanded listing of beers that use the "D" system valve.

The keg coupler connects to the keg valve, "tapping" the keg. Both the gas line from the CO<sub>2</sub> tank / regulator and the beer hose to the beer faucet attach to the coupler.

### Keg Coupler Features

- Stainless Steel body improves durability and resistance to chemicals
- Stainless Steel handle fork for added strength
- Tin-nickel plated probe is resistant chemicals and won't chip like chrome
- Short handle is ideal for the smaller diameter 1/6 kegs
