



"G" System Keg Valve

"G" System - Keg Coupler - Tap w/ Ergo Lever Handle

"G" system gets its name from the English developer, Grundy. The valve face can be thought of as a circle with three sides cut off. It is used by breweries such as Grolsch, Boddington's, Caffrey's and Anchor Steam (50 liter kegs). Please see our website for an expanded listing of beers that use the "G" system valve.

The keg coupler connects to the keg valve, "tapping" the keg. Both the gas line from the CO₂ tank / regulator and the beer hose to the beer faucet attach to the coupler.

Keg Coupler Features

- Coupler sits on top, twist 1/4 turn to connect
- Stainless steel probe
- Short handle ideal for 1/6th barrel kegs
- Easy to engage: push down to tap/pull up to untap
